Our History

Founded in 1912, St. John School is the second oldest continuously operating school in the Tulsa diocese. The two-story, red-brick building, which housed four classrooms, opened for classes on September 9, 1912. The Ursuline Sisters from Paola, Kansas staffed the school. From its earliest days, St. John School served both Catholic and non-Catholic students.

In 1946, increased student enrollment served as justification for the construction of a new school. The current school building was dedicated on September 24, 1950. St. John School has been providing high-quality, Christian-based education for children in Bartlesville and the surrounding communities for almost 100 years.
